WHITMINSTER ENDOWED COE PRIMARY SCHOOL CURRICULUM AND STANDARDS COMMITTEE TERMS OF REFERENCE

- Title:** Curriculum and Standards including pupil matters
- Membership:** The committee shall consist of not less than four governors plus the Head or Senior Management Team member with responsibility for the curriculum. The curriculum committee may make recommendations to the Governing body for co-optation of non-voting members.
- Quorum:** Three Governors including the Head or SMT member.
- Meetings:** The committee shall meet at least 3 times per year and otherwise as required.

Terms of Reference:

- To make recommendations to the Governing body and review the school's curriculum statement as required in the light of the statutory obligations regarding the National Curriculum
- in collaboration with the staff to provide information about how the curriculum is taught, evaluated and resourced
- to review the policy and provision for sex and relationships education and to make recommendations where necessary
- to review the policy and provision for collective worship and RE and make recommendations where necessary
- to monitor and review information about school performance and reporting to parents according to statutory requirements and to present an annual report to the governing body on public examination and national testing
- to contribute to the School Development Plan
- to monitor Special Educational Needs provision and inclusion
- to monitor progress and provision for our vulnerable groups, e.g pupil premium, travellers, young carers, Looked after children
- to be responsible for reviewing policies/subjects as identified on the Governing body's review schedule
