## Year One Spellings

### Compound Words

Two words join to make a new word.

foot + ball = football  
farm + year = farmyard

### Prefix un

-un changes the meaning of a word

happy = unhappy  
do = undo  
fair = unfair

### Suffixes

If you are adding the suffix to a root word then nothing changes.

ing, ed, and er  
jumping jumped jumper

er and est  
fresher freshest

Remember sometime -ed sounds like t, id, or just d but you still use ed

wanted sounds like wanted  
jumped sounds like jump t  
washed sounds like wash d

### Plurals

Plural means there is more than one of a noun.

We can add s: cats dogs birds (sometimes this sounds like a z)  
We can add es: foxes, matches (sometimes this sound like iz)
